## **ERSKINE HAWKINS AND HIS ORCHESTRA** 1938 - 1939

per first major hit by Erskine Hawkins and his Orchestra was "Tuxedo Junction". Its riff was the standard sign-off for all bands appearing at the Savoy Ballroom as they handed over to the next group. One night, when Chick Webb was due to follow Hawkins, Chick's band was several minutes late, While waiting, Erskine's band began improvising on the melody, much to the delight of the dancers. The recording became an instantaneous success! Erskine Ramsay Hawkins was born in Birmingham. Alabama, on July 26, 1914. He started playing drums as a boy, before specializing on trumpet at the age of 13. He also played trombone and tenor-saxophone, as well as showing great talent as an arranger. Hawkins studied for a while at the State Teachers' College of Alabama and played with its band, the 'Bama State Collegians. This group had already achieved a considerable reputation by the time Hawkins replaced singer I.B. Sims as leader. After several tours in the Southern States, the band visited New York for the first time in 1934. Erskine Hawkins and his 'Bama State Collegians appeared at the Harlem Opera House, the Academy of Music and the Fox Folly in Brooklyn, then went on to tour upstate New York. Unable to find further work in New York. Hawkins and his band returned to Alabama. Their second trip, however, proved more successful, with an extended residency at the Savoy Ballroom alongside Chick Webb's Band. Throughout the late thirties and the forties, Erskine Hawkins and his Orchestra were among the most popular bands, particularly with dancers at the Savoy. Due to declining interest in his music. Erskine Hawkins gradually reduced the size of his band in the early fifties. He occasionally fronted big bands for special occasions, but later spent most of his time fronting a quartet in the New York area. In 1979 he made one of his rare European appearances, playing at various jazz festivals. Very little is known about his activities in the eighties. Erskine Hawkins received an Honourable Doctorate in Music from Alabama State College in 1947.

This second volume of the complete recordings of Erskine Hawkins and his Orchestra opens with Sammy Lowe's arrangement of an hold warhorse commonly associated with New Orleans bands. On "King Porter Stomp", the leader plays the first and last trumpet solos, whereas it is Dud Bascomb who is heard after Haywood Henry's baritone. The following three sessions each include one vocal by the lovely Ida James, one of the badly neglected band-singers of the period. She can also be heard on records with the Earl Hines Orchestra already issued in this series, Erskine's session of July 1939 is undoubtedly his best to date. Both "Gin Mill Special" and "Hot Platter" are excellent! Don Redman's "Cherry", although a neat composition, includes a vocal by altosaxophonist limmy Mitchelle. "Tuxedo lunction" has become almost synonymous with Erskine Hawkins: his feeling for derivatives of the blues and his aptitude at transforming them into highly danceable music becomes evident on this fantastic track.
